In 2007, Beau Mills was drafted in the first round (13th overall) by the Cleveland Indians. This marked the start of his professional career. He played in the Indians' farm system for several years, demonstrating his power-hitting abilities and dedication to the game.

In 2018 after being retired from baseball, Beau embarked on a new venture in Texas. He started a bull bucking business, further showcasing his entrepreneurial spirit. This business involved the breeding and training of bulls for rodeos and bull riding events, contributing to the vibrant rodeo culture in Texas.

In February of 2020, tragedy struck Beau Mills' life when he experienced the devastating loss of his son, Beau Bear, who passed away tragically at the age of 18 months old. This heartbreaking event was a profound personal loss that undoubtedly had a significant impact on his life and family.

Following the loss of his son, Beau Mills made a life-changing decision. He sold Red Laces Cattle Company and joined the pastoral staff at StoneWater Church. This transition into pastoral work demonstrated his deep commitment to faith and a desire to support and guide others in their spiritual journeys.

In memory of his late son, Beau and his wife Alicia, established the "Beau Bear Foundation." This foundation is dedicated to honoring Beau Bear's memory by providing support to families who have experienced the loss of a child. The foundation's mission is to offer resources, comfort, and assistance to those navigating the difficult journey of coping with such a profound loss.

Through the Beau Bear Foundation, Beau and Alicia have channeled their grief into a positive force for good, helping other families who have faced similar tragedies find solace and support.

Beau Mills' life journey has been marked by both triumphs on the baseball field, personal challenges, and a deep commitment to his faith and giving back to the community through the Beau Bear Foundation. His story serves as a testament to his resilience, dedication, and compassion for others in their times of need.

Beau Mills resides in Granbury, TX with his wife Alicia and their three children Kensie, James and Hudson.
