Book List of Activities

- 1. Diary: Pretend you are one of the main characters and write a journal entry for each chapter.
- 2. Write a friendly letter to the author.
- 3. Construct a diorama with a summary. It must represent the setting and characters.
- 4. Rewrite the ending of the novel.

- 5. Write an essay about one of the main characters. Are you like him/her or not like him/her?
- 6. Write a poem using the characters, setting, or plot of the novel.
- 7. Design a book quilt with 9 squares. In sequence, draw a picture representing the story plot.
- 8. Explain why you think this novel will or will not be read 100 years from now. Support your opinion by stating specific events in the story.
- 9. Write a ballad, song, or rap about the characters in your book. Set the work to music or song and be prepared to sing it during the first week of school.
- 10. Draw a mural depicting a major scene from the novel and write a summary of that scene.
